I am **Dr. Antonio C. Manila**, representing the CITES-Management Authority of the Philippines, an through this email-message would wish to establish our linkage/network with your country, **Bolivia** or a very important proposal under the CITES. For your information, we personally met and discussed by effly this concern when we met in The Haque, The Netherlands last June 2007 during COP14.

I wish to formally inform you about the Philippines' intention and proposal to undertake collaborative cooperation among Range States in accordance with Res. Conf. 13.9, entitled, "Encouraging cooperation between Parties with *ex-situ* breeding operations and those with *in-situ* conservation programmes".
