Adoption of summary records

The Committee reviewed the summary records CoP19 Com. II. Rec. 2 and CoP19 Com. II. Rec. 3. In CoP19 Com. II. Rec.2, the Center for Biological Diversity provided a correction in respect of the list of members of the working group established under agenda item 23. In CoP19 Com. II. Rec. 3, Canada noted that under agenda item 17.1, the summary record should state that the Chair of the Standing Committee introduced document CoP19 Doc. 17.1.

With these corrections, the summary records in documents CoP19 Com. II. Rec. 2 and CoP19 Com. II. Rec.3 were adopted.

66. Elephants (Elephantidae spp.)

66.4 Trade in live African elephants

66.4.1 International trade in live African elephant specimens: Proposed revision to Resolution Conf. 10.10 (Rev. CoP18) on Trade in elephant specimens

and

66.4.2 Clarifying the framework: Proposal of the European Union

Burkina Faso reiterated its strong support for document Doc. CoP19 Doc. 66.4.1, but also suggested an alternative solution by proposing an amendment to include the establishment of an intersessional working group to be established by the Standing Committee to discuss export of live wild caught African elephants in a transparent manner that included relevant Parties and stakeholders. Benin, Côte d'Ivoire, Ethiopia, Guinea, Guinea-Bissau, Mali, Niger, Senegal, Togo, and Uganda voiced their support for the establishment of an intersessional working group. The European Union and its Member States also indicated that they could potentially support Burkina Faso's proposal depending on other elements of the proposal.

Burkina Faso, supported by Mali, proposed a new draft decision as an addition to Annex 1 to document CoP19 Doc. 66.4.2 as follows:

19.BB The Parties agree that while this intersessional process is under way, any export of live wild-caught African elephant will be limited to *in situ* conservation programmes or secure areas in the wild, within the species' natural and historical range in Africa, except in exceptional circumstances where, in consultation with the Animals committee, through its Chair with the support of the Secretariat, and in consultation with the IUCN African elephant specialist group, it is considered that a transfer to *ex situ* locations will provide demonstrable *in situ* conservation benefits for African elephants, or in the case of temporary transfers in emergency situations.

Botswana, echoed by Zimbabwe, opposed the amendments proposed by Burkina Faso and indicated their support for the proposal by the European Union and its Member States for a dialogue meeting.

Amboseli Ecosystem Trust supported Burkina Faso's proposal. The Global March for Elephants voiced its support for document CoP19 Doc. 66.4.1. SUCO-SA (speaking also on behalf of several observer organizations) stressed the importance of sustainable use for local communities and African elephant range States. The World Wide Fund for Nature (WWF) cautioned that action taken under this agenda item should not adversely impact *in situ* restorative projects involving the southern white rhinoceros.

The Chair noted the various aspects to be considered by the Committee and proposed to consider these in a systematic manner, i.e., the amendments proposed to Resolution Conf. 10.10 (Rev. CoP18) proposed in document CoP19 Doc. 66.4.1; the decisions linked to document CoP19 Doc. 88 contained in document CoP19 Doc. 66.4.2; the proposals relating to a dialogue meeting contained in document CoP19 Doc. 66.4.2 and the two new proposals presented by Burkina Faso (proposed intersessional working group and the draft decision 19.BB relating to trade in live elephants as reflected above).

The Chair concluded that based on discussions the proposal to amend Resolution Conf. 10.10 (Rev. CoP18) in document CoP19 Doc. 66.4.1 was not accepted.

She furthermore indicated that the draft decision 19.AA a) and b) in document CoP19 Doc. 66.4.2 are linked to discussions relating to document CoP19 Doc. 88 and will be addressed in draft decisions to be considered by the Committee under item 88.

The Committee then considered the proposals relating to the dialogue meeting and intersessional working group process.

Burkina Faso reiterated the need for an intersessional working group so that a wider group of stakeholders could be involved. The United States of America proposed amending paragraph c) of draft decision 19.AA in Annex 1 to document CoP19 Doc. 66.4.2 by adding at the end: and recommending other Parties, the CITES Secretariat and technical experts to participate in the meeting in accordance with the Annex to Resolution Conf. 14.5 on *Dialogue meetings*.

The Chair proposed an amendment to draft decision 19.AA in document CoP19 Doc. 66.4.2 so that the draft decision would read as follows:

19.AA The Standing Committee shall:

- a) establish an intersessional working group to consider a harmonization of the conditions to trade in live African elephants and propose relevant changes to Resolutions to the 20th meeting of the Conference of the Parties as well as relevant changes to annotation 2 including changes to streamline and simplify the annotation;
- b) consider calling a CITES dialogue meeting for African elephant range States as per Resolution Conf. 14.5 on *Dialogue meetings* and consider recommending other Parties, the Secretariat and other experts attend the dialogue meeting.

The Democratic Republic of the Congo and Senegal welcomed the Chair's attempt to bring together diverging views but felt that further clarification was needed. Kenya and Mali indicated that they support the proposal by Burkina Faso relating to an intersessional working group, while Eswatini supported the proposal for a dialogue meeting. The Chair called a vote on her draft decision 19.AA above. 40 Parties voted in favour, 43 against and 12 abstained. The proposal was rejected,

The European Union and its Member States proposed to amend draft decision 19.AA c) to delete "consider to". The Committee then voted on paragraph c) of draft decision 19.AA as amended by the European Union and its Member States and the United States of America. 61 Parties voted in favour; 21 against; and 15 abstained. Paragraph c) of draft decision 19.AA in Annex 1 to document CoP19 Doc. 66.4.2 as amended was accepted as follows:

Directed to the Standing Committee

- 19.AA** The Standing Committee shall call a CITES dialogue meeting as per Resolution Conf. 14.5 on *Dialogue meetings* for African elephant range States to consider a harmonization of the conditions to trade in live African elephants and propose relevant changes to Resolutions to CoP20 as well as relevant changes to annotation 2, including changes to streamline and simplify the annotation; and recommend other Parties, the CITES Secretariat and technical experts to participate in the meeting in accordance with the Annex to Resolution Conf. 14.5 on *Dialogue meetings*.

Burkina Faso's proposal for new draft decision 19.BB under agenda item 66.4.2 relating to trade in live elephants was amended to replace "this intersessional process" with the process for the dialogue meeting and was subject to a vote. 61 Parties voted in favour of the proposal, 18 against, and 18 abstained. The draft decision was accepted as follows.

Directed to Parties

- 19.BB** The Parties agree that while the process for the dialogue meeting is under way, any export of live wild-caught African elephant will be limited to *in situ* conservation programmes or secure areas in the wild, within the species' natural and historical range in Africa, except in exceptional circumstances where, in consultation with the Animals committee, through its Chair with the support of the Secretariat, and in consultation with the IUCN African elephant specialist group, it is considered that a transfer to *ex situ* locations will provide demonstrable *in situ* conservation benefits for African elephants, or in the case of temporary transfers in emergency situations.

66.2 Ivory stockpiles

66.2.1 Ivory stockpiles: implementation of Resolution Conf. 10.10 (Rev. CoP18) on *Trade in elephant specimens*

Burkina Faso introduced document CoP19 Doc. 66.2.1 on enhancing reporting and security of ivory stockpiles in compliance with paragraph 7 of Resolution Conf. 10.10 (Rev. CoP18) on *Trade in elephant specimens*, stating that stockpiles stimulated demand for ivory and therefore posed a serious threat to African elephants.

Benin, Equatorial Guinea, Ethiopia, Gabon, India, Liberia, Kenya, Mali, Mauritania, Senegal, Togo, the United States of America and the Center for Biological Diversity, speaking also on behalf of 20 observer organizations, supported the draft decisions in document CoP19 Doc. 66.2.1.

Botswana, China, the European Union and its Member States, Japan, the Lao People's Democratic Republic, Namibia, South Africa, Thailand and the United Republic of Tanzania did not support the draft decisions. These Parties variously expressed concerns that the new model inventory form in Annex 1 to document CoP19 Doc. 66.2.1 would increase the burden on Parties with ivory stockpiles and believed that existing reporting requirements were sufficient. Some of the Parties also expressed concerns about the decisions directed at Parties to destroy stockpiles, indicating that this is a domestic matter. Japan proposed the deletion of decision 19.AA b) and of "...and when appropriate, properly disposed of for non-commercial purposes" in the last sentence of draft decision 19.AA in document CoP19 Doc. 66.2.1. Japan expressed concern that there were few Parties reporting privately held stockpile of ivory due

to the limited criteria and lack of the common standards for the protection of data relating to stockpiles of individuals and private entities, and furthermore expressed the need to expand the reporting by Parties especially destination countries and countries who historically used ivory in their markets.

To foster consensus, Gabon noted it could accept the Secretariat's amendments to the draft decisions in document CoP19 Doc. 66.2.1 with one further amendment, to include a new paragraph a) to 19.BB as follows:

19.BB The Secretariat shall:

- a) update the model inventory form taking into account the declaration of ivory stocks and model inventory form proposed in Annex 1 to document CoP19 Doc. 66.2.1 and use this updated model inventory form when publishing future notifications to Parties"

Benin, Burkina Faso, Côte d'Ivoire, Israel, Kenya, Mali, Niger, Togo and the United States supported the draft decision as amended by Gabon. Botswana, China, the Democratic Republic of the Congo, the United Republic of Tanzania, Zambia and Zimbabwe opposed the proposed amendment by Gabon.

Noting the lack of consensus, the Chair called for a vote on decision 19.BB as amended by Gabon.

With 34 in favour, 52 opposed and 13 abstentions, Gabon's amendment to draft decision 19.BB was rejected.

Draft decisions 19.AA, 19.BB and 19.CC as amended by the Secretariat were accepted.

66.2.2. Establishing a fund accessible to range States upon non-commercial disposal of ivory stockpiles

Kenya introduced document CoP19 Doc. 66.2.2 which proposed the establishment of an intersessional working group to explore the idea of a fund that elephant range States could access upon the destruction of ivory stockpiles. This was proposed as a means of avoiding the resumption of any commercial ivory sales and to provide funding for elephant range States to support conservation initiatives and efforts to reduce human-wildlife conflict. Kenya also drew attention to information document CoP19 Inf. 84 which provided details of potential funding mechanisms.

The meeting was adjourned at 12h00.
