SELECTION OF SPECIES FOR THE PERIODIC REVIEW

- 1. This document has been prepared by the Secretariat.
- 2. Resolution Conf. 14.8 (Rev. CoP16) on Periodic Review of species included in Appendices I and II agrees that the Animals Committee shall establish a schedule for the Periodic Review of the Appendices and identify a list of taxa it proposes to review during the next two intersessional periods between meetings of the Conference of the Parties. The list should be established at the first meetings of the Committee after the meeting of the Conference of the Parties that initiates the review period, and the reviews should be conducted following the guidelines outlined in the Resolution. If the Animals Committee were to establish a schedule or list at the present meeting in accordance with these provisions, the period to review the identified taxa would run from the 16th (CoP16, Bangkok, 2013) to the 18th meeting of the Conference of the Parties (CoP18, 2019).
- Through Decisions 16.124, 16.125 and 13.93 (Rev. CoP16), the Animals Committee is directed to include Cuora galbinifrons, Mauremys annamensis, Chelodina mccordi and Felidae in its Periodic Review of the Appendices following CoP16 (see documents AC27 Doc. 24.3.1 and AC27 Doc. 24.3.2).

Recommendation

4. The Animals Committee is invited to consider the selection of species for the Periodic Review, as outlined in paragraph 2 above.
