OVERVIEW OF THE REVIEW OF SIGNIFICANT TRADE

- 1. This document has been prepared by the Secretariat.
- 2. In Resolution Conf. 12.8 (Rev. CoP18) on *Review of Significant Trade in specimens of Appendix-II species*, the Conference of the Parties:
 - 5. DIRECTS the Secretariat, for the purpose of monitoring and facilitating the implementation of this Resolution and the relevant paragraphs of Article IV:
 - a) to report at each meeting of the Animals or Plants Committee on the implementation by the range States concerned of the recommendations made by the Committee; and
 - b) to maintain a database of species/country combinations that are included in the review process set out in this Resolution including a record of progress with the implementation of recommendations;

Implementation by range States of recommendations made by the Animals Committee

- 3. The last update of the status of the Review of Significant Trade for fauna species was reported to the Animals Committee at its 30th meeting (AC30, Geneva, July 2018; see document <u>AC30 Doc. 12.1</u>). At its 70th meeting (SC70, Sochi, October 2018), the Standing Committee reviewed 14 cases that were ongoing but not subject to a recommendation to suspend trade (see document <u>SC70 Doc. 29.1</u>). The review of *Antipatharia*/Taiwan, Province of China, was concluded at SC70 with the publication of a zero export quota. The Standing Committee also recommended a suspension of trade in specimens of *Trioceros montium* from Cameroon until that country demonstrates compliance with Article IV, paragraphs 2 (a) and 3, for trade in this species. All other species/range State combinations were retained within the review.
- 4. In addition, in compliance with paragraph 1 p) of Resolution Conf. 12.8 (Rev. CoP18) for cases where the trade suspension had been in place for more than two years, the Standing Committee reviewed 56 fauna species/range State combinations that have been subject to long standing trade suspensions (see document <u>SC70 Doc. 29.2</u>).
 - a) The following five reviews were concluded and the recommendations to suspend trade removed: *Stigmochelys pardalis*/Democratic Republic of the Congo; *Phelsuma breviceps* and *P. standingi*/Madagascar; *Poicephalus fuscicollis*/Mali; and *Hippocampus kuda*/Viet Nam.

- b) The recommendations to suspend trade were also removed, subject to the publication of a zero export quota on the CITES website, for: *Ptyas mucosus, Python reticulatus, Naja* spp. (*N. atra, N. kaouthia, N. siamensis*), *Heosemys annandalii, H. grandis* and *Cuora galbinifrons*/Lao People's Democratic Republic; and *Agapornis fischeri* and *Malacochersus tornieri*/United Republic of Tanzania.
- c) The recommendations to suspend trade were retained for the remaining 41 species/range State combinations and are highlighted in the table in Annex 2 to this document.
- 5. At its 71st meeting (SC71, Geneva, August 2019), the Standing Committee reviewed five cases (see document <u>SC71 Doc. 12</u>). The following species/range State combinations were retained within the review: *Amazona festiva/*Guyana; *Testudo graeca/*Jordan; *Trioceros melleri/*Mozambique and *Chelonoidis denticulatus/*Suriname. It was agreed to remove *Varanus ornatus* from Togo from the review subject to the publication of an export quota of 25 wild specimens and 350 ranched specimens. Togo has not submitted a request to the Secretariat for the publication of this quota and is therefore retained in the review.
- 6. At its 18th meeting (CoP18, Geneva, 2019), the Conference of the Parties decided to transfer *Balearica pavonina* from Appendix II to Appendix I. As a result, Resolution Conf. 12. 8 (Rev. CoP18) no longer applies and the review of trade in this species and the related suspensions of trade in *B. pavonina* from Guinea, South Sudan and Sudan are consequently no longer in force.
- 7. The most recent list of range States under a recommendation to suspend trade for certain species selected for the Review of Significant Trade, and following non-compliance with Article IV of the Convention, was published in Notification to the Parties <u>No. 2020/006</u> of 20 January 2020. The recommendations and decisions were made in accordance with Resolution Conf. 12.8 (Rev. CoP18), Resolution Conf. 12.8 (Rev. CoP17), or Resolution Conf. 12.8 (Rev. CoP13), or its predecessor Resolution Conf. 8.9 (Rev.). The cases involving a suspension of trade are kept under regular review by the Standing Committee in line with paragraph 1 p) of Resolution Conf. 12.8 (Rev. CoP18).
- 8. Annex 1 to the present document provides an updated overview of all cases (fauna species/range State combinations) since the 30th meeting of the Animals Committee (AC30), with an indication of their current status under the review process, and the reference documents that provide detailed information for the cases in question. It also indicates the reviews that were completed since AC30. Annex 2 presents a summary table of all fauna range State/species combinations subject to a recommendation to suspend trade under RST or for which the review process is currently ongoing.
- Further information on species selected by the Animals Committee for the Review of Significant Trade following the 15th, 16th and 17th meetings of the Conference of the Parties (CoP15, Doha, 2010; CoP16, Bangkok, 2013 and CoP17, Johannesburg, 2016) is provided in documents AC31 Doc.13.2 and AC31 Doc. 13.3.

Decisions 17.108 (Rev. CoP18) to 17.110 (Rev. CoP18) on Review of Significant Trade

- 10. Decision 17.108 (Rev. CoP18) requests the Secretariat, within six months of CoP18, and building on the work done to date, to develop, test and establish a Review of Significant Trade Tracking and Management database as an essential tool for the effective implementation and transparency of the process.
- 11. Decision 17.108 (Rev. CoP18) is currently being implemented thanks to a contribution from the European Union. Following United Nations rules and procedures, the Secretariat entered into a Service Delivery Agreement with the United Nations International Computing Centre (UNICC) for the development of the tracking and management system given its vast experience in the development of such tools. The Secretariat also convened a Technical Advisory Group to consult on the requirements of the tracking and management system. The Technical Advisory Group is comprised of Parties that have been subject to the Review of Significant Trade, individuals with experience in database development and use, as well as representatives of interested non-governmental organizations. Throughout the development and testing phase, the Secretariat intends to consult the Technical Advisory Group to ensure that the tracking and management system matches the requirements of different users, including the Parties that are part of the Review of Significant Trade.
- 12 At CoP18, the Secretariat organised a side event where representatives of UNICC presented the project to the Technical Advisory Group. Since then, the development of the tracking and management system is well under way and is envisaged to be completed by October 2020.

13. Decisions 17.109 (Rev. CoP18) and 17.110 (Rev. CoP18) are both directed to the Secretariat to develop, subject to the availability of funds, respectively: a user-friendly guide to the Review of Significant Trade that can also be included in the initial letter to range States informing them that they have been selected for review; and a comprehensive training module on the Review of Significant Trade (including case studies as appropriate). These Decisions will be implemented in parallel with the development and completion of the tracking and management system.

Recommendation

14. The Animals Committee is invited to take note of this document.
