### <u>Mandate</u>

Taking into account Decision 14.40 (Rev. CoP16), and considering the report of the Secretariat in document PC21 Doc. 16,"determine whether there are any taxa of Appendix-II plants artificially propagated for which detailed reporting is less valuable".

### Recommendations

- 1. In response to Decision 14.40 (Rev. COP16), based on available information, no Appendix-II plants artificially propagated were identified for which detailed reporting is less valuable.
- 2. Additionally the Working group suggest PC not to support Secretariat's recommendation under paragraph 17 of Document PC21 Doc.16, to amend the mandate Standing Committee Working Group on Special Reporting Requirements.
