## Review of Significant Trade in specimens of Appendix-II species

## OVERVIEW OF THE REVIEW OF SIGNIFICANT TRADE

1. This document has been prepared by the Secretariat.

### **Background**

- 2. In Resolution Conf. 12.8 (Rev. CoP17) on Review of Significant Trade in specimens of Appendix-II species, the Conference of the Parties:
  - DIRECTS the Secretariat, for the purpose of monitoring and facilitating the implementation of this Resolution and the relevant paragraphs of Article IV:
    - a) to report at each meeting of the Animals or Plants Committee on the implementation by the range States concerned of the recommendations made by the Committee; and
    - b) to maintain a database of species/country combinations that are included in the review process set out in this Resolution including a record of progress with the implementation of recommendations.
- 3. The last update of the status of the Review of Significant Trade for flora species was reported to the Plants Committee at its 22nd meeting (PC22, Tbilisi, October 2015; see document PC22 Doc. 11.2).
- 4. The most recent list of countries under a recommendation to suspend trade for certain species selected for the Review of Significant Trade, and following non-compliance with Article IV of the Convention was published in Notification to the Parties No. 2016/018 of 15 March 2016. The recommendations and decisions were made in accordance with Resolution Conf. 12.8 (Rev. CoP13) valid at the time of the Notification, or its predecessor Resolution Conf. 8.9 (Rev.). The cases involving a suspension of trade are kept under regular review by the Standing Committee in line with paragraph 1 p) of Resolution Conf. 12.8 (Rev. CoP17).
- 5. The Annex to the present document provides an updated overview of all these ongoing cases (flora species / range State combinations), with an indication of their current status under the review process, and the reference documents that provide detailed information for the cases in question. It also indicates the reviews that were completed.
- 6. Further information on species selected by the Plants Committee for the Review of Significant Trade following the 16th meeting of the Conference of the Parties (CoP16, Bangkok, 2013) is provided in document PC23 Doc. 15.2.
- At its 17th meeting (CoP17, Johannesburg, 2016), the Conference of the Parties adopted amendments to Resolution Conf. 12.8 (Rev. CoP13) on Review of Significant Trade in specimens of Appendix-II species, as outlined in document CoP17 Doc. 33, allowing for a more transparent, timely and simple process for

conducting the reviews. The revised Resolution provides clear guidance and recommendations for the selection of species/country combinations to be reviewed, the consultation process with the range States, the compilation of information, the categorization and recommendations from the Animals and Plants Committees, measures to be taken regarding the implementation of recommendations and support to the range States. The new process will be initiated at this meeting with the selection of new species for reviews post CoP17 (see document PC23 Doc. 15.3).

## Decisions 17.108 to 17.110 on Review of Significant Trade

- 8. Decision 17.108 requests the Secretariat, within six months of the adoption of Resolution Conf. 12.8 (Rev. CoP17) and building on the work done to date, to develop, test and establish a Review of Significant Trade Tracking and Management database as an essential tool for the effective implementation and transparency of the process. The Secretariat has carefully reviewed the best approaches to implement Decision 17.108 by inventorving and identifying problems with the existing database that need to be adjusted or modified to suit the new Review of Significant Trade process; discussing options for improvements with the authors of the existing database; and developing a realistic project plan and timeframe. Progress depends on the availability of external funds.
- 9. Decisions 17.109 and 17.110 are both directed to the Secretariat, calling it, subject to the availability of funds, to develop respectively: a user-friendly guide to the Review of Significant Trade that can also be included in the initial letter to range States; and a comprehensive training module on the Review of Significant Trade (including case studies as appropriate). Thanks to the generous support from the European Union, the necessary resources have now been secured to move these Decisions forward.
- 10. The Secretariat intends to provide oral updates at the present meeting on progress regarding the implementation of Decisions 17.108 to 17.110.

### Recommendation

11. The Plants Committee is invited to note this document.
