## CONVENTION ON INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN ENDANGERED SPECIES OF WILD FAUNA AND FLORA

#### Committee Reports and Recommendations

### IDENTIFICATION MANUAL COMMITTEE

#### 1. Introduction

The Committee still has no Chairman. The Secretariat is therefore presenting the report.

The Secretariat takes this opportunity to express its serious concern about the lack of functioning of this Committee.

#### 2. General Activities

The former Chairman, who is still administrating the Committee's account, contracted, in 1990, Dr Jean-Pierre Biber as part-time editor for the English edition. The editor's duties include the updating, for the purposes of the Manual, the checklists of the species included in the appendices and the provision of camera-ready manuscripts. As a consequence, the printing costs could be considerably reduced. In 1991, the contract was extended to cover also the editing of the French edition. This contract ends on 30 April 1992 and may be prolonged, depending on the decisions of the Conference.

Since 1979, only 20 Parties have submitted manuscripts of data sheets. The main contributor has been Switzerland (46 %), followed by Canada (11 %), Australia and the United Kingdom (9 % each).

None of the Parties which successfully proposed, at the Lausanne meeting, the inclusion in Appendix I or II of new taxa has complied with Resolution Conf. 5.17 by providing the corresponding ID-Manual data sheets. Apparently the listing itself is considered to be more important than the subsequent enforcement.

In addition, with the exception of Canada and Uruguay, none of the Parties having included species in Appendix III has submitted manuscripts on the species concerned (Colombia, Ghana, Guatemala, Honduras, India, Mauritius, Thailand, Tunisia).

A circular letter sent to all Committee members in Spring 1991 revealed that most members are still interested in receiving their copies of the Manual. However only three Committee members offered to take care of the preparation of new data sheets: Wayne King (USA) of the sheets on three Iguanidae species and four fish species; Ulrike Goldschmid (Austria) of the sheets on all remaining Cercopithecidae; and D.H.W. Morgan (United Kingdom) of the sheets relating to the species included in the appendices at COP 6 on proposals from the United Kingdom.

If no new contributions are submitted, the editor will concentrate his work on the revision of existing sheets.

### 3. English Edition

After the Lausanne meeting, counterpart contributions were received only from Switzerland (Boidae, Phasianidae, Cacatuinae), the Netherlands (*Balaeniceps rex*) and the United States (colour chart on macaws). In addition, Switzerland has made a contract to finalize the section on Tayassuidae.

The following sections of volume 1, 2 and 2a have been printed and distributed to the Parties:
