The Secretariat shall:

- 13.xx a) distribute the Addis Ababa Principles and Guidelines for the Sustainable Use of Biodiversity to all CITES Management and Scientific Authorities;
 - b) invite the Parties to provide the Animals and Plants Committees with case studies on how these Principles and Guidelines could be used in specific cases of exports of CITES Appendix-II species;
 - c) incorporate **consideration of** these Principles and Guidelines into its work plan, with reference to CITES non-detriment findings and capacity building, in particular for CITES Scientific Authorities; and
 - d) incorporate relevant Principles and Guidelines as identified by the Animals or Plants Committees into its capacity-building programme for CITES Scientific Authorities;

Directed to the Animals and Plants Committees

13.xx The Animals and Plants Committees shall identify those Principles and Guidelines of most relevance to CITES also taking account of case studies provided by the Parties, on how these could be used in specific cases of exports of CITES Appendix-II species, and report at CoP14;
