DRAFT RESOLUTION OF THE CONFERENCE OF THE PARTIES.

Amendments to Resolution Conf. 12.9 on Personal and household effects

- 1. Add to paragraph b) under RECOMMENDS, the following new subparagraphs v) and vi):
 - v) specimens of <u>unworked</u> dead corals, as defined in Resolution Conf. 11.10 (Rev. CoP12), of Helioporidae, Scleractinia, Milleporidae, Scleractinia, Stylasteridae and Tubiporidae spp. excluding Antipatharia spp. (black corals) – up to six four pieces, not exceeding 1 kilogram in total, per person;
 - vi) shells of giant clam (*Tridacnidae* spp.) one <u>dead</u> specimen, <u>which may be one intact shell or two matching halves</u>, (i.e. one intact shell or two matching halves) not exceeding 1 kilogram per person. The meat is not included in this exemption.
- 2. Delete the paragraph under REQUESTS.
