CoP15).
- 17.XX2 The Plants Committee, following the above review, shall consider if Resolution Conf. 11.11 (Rev. CoP15) and other relevant Resolutions need to be revised, and as appropriate, propose such amendments for consideration to the 70th meeting of the Standing Committee.
