CONSIDERATION OF PROPOSALS FOR AMENDMENT OF APPENDICES I AND II

A. Proposal

Amend the annotations to the listing of *Vicugna vicugna* in Appendices I and II for the populations of Chile so as to reflect the new names of the regions in which the species occurs.

The only reason for this amendment is the change of name in the territorial division of the First Region of Tarapacá, as provided by Chilean Law No. 20.175. Accordingly, the sole purpose of this proposal is to correct the political and administrative name currently used to refer to the **newly-established Region of Arica and Parinacota**, **formerly part of the First Region of Tarapacá**.

The proposal is to change the reference to the populations of Chile in the annotations in Appendices I and II for the species *Vicugna vicugna*, to read as follows:

Annotation Appendix I:

Vicugna vicugna [Except the populations of: Argentina (the populations of the Provinces of Jujuy and Catamarca and the semi-captive populations of the Provinces of Jujuy, Salta, Catamarca, La Rioja and San Juan), **Chile (the populations of the Tarapacá Region, and the Arica and Parinacota Region)**, Ecuador (the whole population), Peru (the whole population) and the Plurinational State of Bolivia (the whole population), which are included in Appendix II]

Annotation Appendix II:

Vicugna vicugna: [Only the populations of Argentina (the populations of the Provinces of Jujuy and Catamarca and the semi-captive populations of the Provinces of Jujuy, Salta, Catamarca, La Rioja and San Juan), **Chile (the populations of the Tarapacá Region, and the Arica and Parinacota Region)**, Ecuador (the whole population), Peru (the whole population) and the Plurinational State of Bolivia (the whole population); all other populations are included in Appendix I].

For the exclusive purpose of allowing international trade in fibre from vicuñas (Vicugna vicugna) and their derivative products, only if the fibre comes from the shearing of live vicuñas. Trade in products derived from the fibre may only take place in accordance with the following provisions:

- a) Any person or entity processing vicuña fibre to manufacture cloth and garments must request authorization from the relevant authorities of the country of origin (Countries of origin: The countries where the species occurs, that is, Argentina, Bolivia, Chile, Ecuador and Peru) to use the "vicuña country of origin" wording, mark or logo adopted by the range States of the species that are signatories to the Convention for the Conservation and Management of the Vicuña.
- b) Marketed cloth or garments must be marked or identified in accordance with the following provisions:
 - i) For international trade in cloth made from live-sheared vicuña fibre, whether the cloth was produced within or outside of the range States of the species, the wording, mark or logo must be used so that the country of origin can be identified. The VICUÑA [COUNTRY OF ORIGIN] wording, mark or logo has the format as detailed below:



This wording, mark or logo must appear on the reverse side of the cloth. In addition, the selvages of the cloth must bear the words VICUÑA [COUNTRY OF ORIGIN].

- ii) For international trade in garments made from live-sheared vicuña fibre, whether the garments were produced within or outside of the range States of the species, the wording, mark or logo indicated in paragraph b) i) must be used. This wording, mark or logo must appear on a label on the garment itself. If the garments are produced outside of the country of origin, the name of the country where the garment was produced should also be indicated, in addition to the wording, mark or logo referred to in paragraph b) i).
- For international trade in handicraft products made from live-sheared vicuña fibre produced within the range States of the species, the VICUÑA [COUNTRY OF ORIGIN] - ARTESANÍA wording, mark or logo must be used as detailed below:

- If live-sheared vicuña fibre from various countries of origin is used for the production of cloth and garments, the wording, mark or logo of each of the countries of origin of the fibre must be indicated, as detailed in paragraphs b) i) and ii).
- All other specimens shall be deemed to be specimens of species listed in Appendix I and the trade in them shall be regulated accordingly.

2. Overview

At its 6th meeting (Ottawa, Canada 1987), the Conference of the Parties adopted a proposal submitted by Chile to transfer part of the population of *Vicugna vicugna* of Parinacota Province, First Region of Tarapacá, from Appendix I to Appendix II, under specific conditions.

Subsequently, the 12th meeting of the Conference of the Parties to CITES (Santiago, Chile 2002) adopted a proposal submitted by Chile to amend the Appendices with regard to the species *Vicugna vicugna*, whereby the whole population of the First Region of Tarapacá, including the Province of Arica and Parinacota, was transferred to Appendix II.

With regard to the change proposed herein, it is important to bear in mind that until April 2007 the two provinces, Parinacota and Arica, formed part of the First Region of Tarapacá; accordingly, the vicuña populations of these provinces were included in Appendix 2 due to the fact that they were comprised in the First Region.

In April 2007, Chile promulgated Law 20.175 (Annex 1) establishing the XV Region of Arica and Parinacota. The purpose of this law on the country's political and administrative divisions was, among others, to establish the Region of Arica and Parinacota, encompassing territories from the existing Region of Tarapacá (Article 1 of said Law), thereby dividing the First Region of Tarapacá into two administrative regions: the First Region of Tarapacá, which kept the original name, and the new region, which was to be known as the XV Region of Arica and Parinacota.

Accordingly, the annotations need to be amended to ensure that they are consistent with the political and administrative change established under Law 20.175.
