## Trade in plants – stricter domestic measure

- 1. The Secretariat has been requested by the CITES Management Authority of Madagascar to inform the Parties of its new regulation that imposes a stricter domestic measure concerning the export of wild flora, in accordance with Article XIV, paragraph 1, of the Convention.
- 2. No specimen of any CITES-listed plant species, including seeds, spores, pollen, *in vitro* cultures and cut flowers, may be exported without an export permit.
- 3. Parties are requested to take note of the above information and to assist in ensuring that all imports of CITES-listed plant specimens from Madagascar are accompanied by an appropriate permit or certificate.
