Does Ruby Lane permit the sale of items made from Ivory or other endangered species?

Ivory and Endangered Species Site-wide Guidelines

- 1. Ivory may no longer be listed or sold on Ruby Lane as of August 17,
- 2. Antique items made in whole or in part of any species listed in CITES Appendix I must include the following declaration:

"All state and federal documentation and certificates required by law for commercial sale, import or export, have been obtained for this item. Proper legal paperwork will be included with it at

If the shop owner does not have all the necessary paperwork required by law or they do, but the declaration above is not included in their listing, the item may not remain for sale on Ruby Lane and we may choose to remove the listing.

If you are unsure whether or not the plant or animal-based product you have to sell is made from a species listed in Appendix I, you should check



Endangered or Threatened Wildlife Products

An important part of creating a sustainable future is protecting wildlife from extinction. To conserve species that are most vulnerable, Etsy prohibits the sale of products made from endangered or threatened animals as identified by the CITES Appendix I and the US Endangered Species Act.

Some examples of prohibited species include but are not limited to

- · Cetaceans (e.g. Dolphins, Porpoises, Whales)
- Chinchillas
- · Corals (Elkhorn, Staghorn)
- Flenhants Marine Turtles
- Primates (e.g. Bonobo, Chimpanzee, Gorilla, Monkeys, Orangutan)
- · Protected Birds (e.g. Falcons, Eagles, and Parrots



Endangered/ Threatened Species Products or Services

Advertising that promotes the trading or sale of products or services derived from endangered or threatened species is not allowed. This Advertising for the sale and shipment of live animals is also prohibited. A few examples are included below, A complete list can be found in this document concerning wildlife-friendly online trade.

- · Elephant ivon
- · Leopard, tiger, or lion hide/skin
- · Live animals such as tortoises or turtles
- · Rhino horns
- · Sale of tigers or other endangered/threatened animals
- Shark fins
- · Whale or dolphin hunting trips



Prohibited items: Animals

- · Cats
- . Dogs · Fish
- Marine mammals
- . Reptiles such as lizards or snakes . Horses or nonles
- . Hamsters partitle rabbits or other nets
- · Farm animals such as chickens, goats, pigs, or cow
