CUADRO PANORÁMICO DE ESPECIES INCLUIDAS EN EL EXAMEN PERIÓDICO

1. Este documento ha sido preparado por la Secretaría.
2. En la Resolución Conf. 14.8 (Rev. CoP16), sobre *Examen periódico de especies incluidas en los Apéndices I y II*, la Conferencia de las Partes acuerda un proceso y unas directrices para que los Comités de Fauna y de Flora realicen un examen periódico de las especies de fauna y de flora incluidas en los Apéndices de la CITES, y en el párrafo 6:
 6. *ENCARGA a la Secretaría que mantenga un registro de las especies seleccionadas para el examen periódico, incluidas las especies examinadas anteriormente y actualmente, fechas de los documentos pertinentes del Comité, recomendaciones de los exámenes y cualesquiera otros informes y documentos conexos.*
3. En el Anexo 1 se muestra el registro de las especies de plantas seleccionadas para su examen entre las reuniones 13ª y 15ª de la Conferencia de las Partes (CoP13, Bangkok, 2004 y CoP15, Doha, 2010).
4. El registro de las especies de plantas seleccionadas para su examen entre la CoP15 y la 17ª reunión de la Conferencia de las Partes (CoP17, Johannesburgo, 2016) figura en el Anexo 2.
5. En el Anexo 3 se incluye un resumen de todos los casos de los Anexos 1 y 2 (seleccionados antes de la CoP17) que siguen en curso.
6. Las especies de plantas seleccionadas para el Examen periódico entre la 17ª y la 19ª reunión de la Conferencia de las Partes (CoP19, 2022) figuran en el Anexo 4.
7. De acuerdo con el párrafo 2 c) de la Resolución Conf. 14.8 (Rev. CoP17), el Comité de Flora inició el período de examen más reciente durante su primera reunión después de la 17ª reunión de la Conferencia de las Partes, basándose en los resultados obtenidos de conformidad con el párrafo 2 b) de la Resolución (los datos y el análisis del comercio correspondientes al período 2006-2015 que fueron preparados por el Centro Mundial de Monitoreo de la Conservación del Programa de las Naciones Unidas para el Medio Ambiente (PNUMA-WCMC) a petición de la Secretaría. El Comité formuló una lista de posibles taxones para ser incluidos en el examen periódico durante los próximos dos períodos entre sesiones, es decir, entre la 17ª y la 19ª reunión de la Conferencia de las Partes en 2022.
8. En su 23ª reunión (PC23, Ginebra, julio de 2017), el Comité de Flora tuvo en consideración la información contenido en el documento [PC23 Doc. 29.2](#) y seleccionó veinte especies de plantas como candidatas para ser incluidas en el Examen periódico conforme a la Resolución Conf. 14.8 (Rev. CoP17). En el cuadro siguiente, se indican las especies, el Apéndice de inclusión y los Estados de distribución. El nombre de

aquellos Estados del área de distribución que ya se han ofrecido voluntariamente a llevar a cabo el examen figura en **negrita**.

9. Conforme al párrafo 2 d) de la Resolución Conf. 14.8 (Rev. CoP17), el 24 de octubre de 2017, la Secretaría envió la Notificación No. 2017/069, para informar a las Partes de la lista propuesta de taxones a incluir en el examen y para invitar a los Estados del área de distribución a que informaran a la Secretaría en un plazo de 60 días (antes del 23 de diciembre de 2017) si apoyaban el examen periódico de esos taxones y expresaran su interés en realizar los exámenes correspondientes.
10. No se recibieron respuestas sobre las especies de plantas seleccionadas para el examen. La Secretaría espera poder presentar una actualización verbal durante la presente reunión sobre otros países que posiblemente puedan realizar el examen de las especies seleccionadas.
11. En el Anexo 5 figura una lista de las abreviaturas y en el Anexo 6 figura una lista de los códigos ISO de los países.

Recomendaciones

12. Se invita al Comité de Flora a:

- a) tomar nota de este documento; y
- b) para el examen de *Lewisia serrata*, presentado por los Estados Unidos de América (véase el documento PC24 Doc. 25.2.1), y de conformidad con los párrafos 2 g) y h) de la Resolución Conf. 14.8 (Rev. CoP17), determinar si convendría mantener el taxón en el Apéndice en que se encuentra incluido actualmente, o si procede transferirlo de un Apéndice a otro o suprimirlo de los Apéndices; y, en los casos en que la inclusión actual no se considere adecuada, formular una recomendación haciendo referencia a los criterios establecidos en la Resolución Conf. 9.24 (Rev. CoP17) sobre *Criterios para enmendar los Apéndices I y II*.

¹ At PC18, the Committee maintained an intersessional working group on *Aloe* spp. and *Euphorbia* spp. – both listed in Appendix I – and *Didiereaceae* spp. The reviews required under the provisions of the Resolution Conf. 14.8 (Rev. CoP17) were presented in document PC18 Doc. 16.1.1, Annex 5, but it is not clear if there is enough information for the Committee to decide whether or not the listing criteria established by the Resolution Conf. 9.24 (Rev. CoP16) have been met. The Plants Committee, at its 21st meeting, agreed that there is insufficient information to determine if the 17 species of *Aloe* spp. in Appendix I; 17 species of *Didiereaceae* spp. in Appendix II and 10 species of *Euphorbia* spp. in Appendix I that were selected for the review period CoP13-CoP15 are appropriately listed in the Appendices. Madagascar was requested to submit a revised and updated version of Annex 5 of document PC18 Doc. 16.1.1 to PC22, which should contain recommendations for the appropriate listing of the species and which should be translated. At PC22, Madagascar introduced document PC22 Doc. 20.3.1. While noting that *Didiereaceae* was not endemic to Madagascar, speakers supported the conclusion reached by Madagascar, proposing no change to the current listing of these species. The review of *Aloe helenae* from Madagascar is ongoing (see Annex 1).
