VUE D'ENSEMBLE DES ESPÈCES DANS L'EXAMEN PÉRIODIQUE

1. Le présent document a été préparé par le Secrétariat.
2. Dans la résolution Conf. 14.8 (Rev. CoP17), *Examen périodique des espèces inscrites aux Annexes I et II*, la Conférence des Parties décide d'un processus et de lignes directrices selon lesquels le Comité pour les animaux et le Comité pour les plantes entreprennent l'examen périodique des espèces animales et végétales inscrites aux annexes CITES, et dans le paragraphe 6:

DONNE INSTRUCTION au Secrétariat de tenir un registre des espèces sélectionnées pour un examen périodique, y compris des espèces ayant fait l'objet ou faisant actuellement l'objet d'un examen, dates des documents pertinents du comité, recommandations des examens, et tout rapport et documents liés.

3. L'annexe 1 contient un registre des espèces animales sélectionnées pour l'examen entre la 13^e et la 15^e sessions de la Conférence des Parties (CoP13, Bangkok, 2004 et CoP15, Doha, 2010).
4. Le registre des espèces animales à examiner entre la 15^e et la 17^e sessions de la Conférence des Parties (CoP17, Johannesburg, 2016) figure en annexe 2. Le registre des espèces de plantes à examiner entre la 15^e et la 17^e sessions de la Conférence des Parties (CoP17, Johannesburg, 2016) figure en annexe 2.
5. À sa 21^e session (PC21; Veracruz, mai 2014), le Comité pour les plantes a examiné les registres des espèces sélectionnées pour un examen périodique et formulé plusieurs recommandations qui sont dûment reprises dans les tableaux en annexes 1 et 2.
6. Une liste d'abréviations de la Liste rouge des espèces menacées de l'UICM figure dans l'annexe 3 et les codes ISO des pays figurent dans l'annexe 4. Les deux périodes d'examen sont résumées ci-dessous:

7. Les registres des espèces sélectionnées pour l'examen périodique, figurant dans les annexes 1 à 3, suivent la même présentation que les soumissions précédentes du Secrétariat. Cependant, on ne sait pas clairement s'il est nécessaire de tenir à jour les champs de données contenant des informations qui pourraient varier avec le temps (état de conservation; aire de répartition) et le Secrétariat apprécierait des orientations à ce sujet. En outre, dans ses commentaires sur le document [CoP17 Doc. 82.1](#), le Secrétariat a indiqué que la tenue des registres de l'examen périodique est de plus en plus exigeante. Il serait préférable d'élaborer une base de données en ligne, gérable et consultable, sur l'examen périodique. Le Secrétariat n'a pas de fonds administratifs à consacrer à ces activités et un financement externe serait nécessaire pour établir et maintenir une base de données sur l'examen périodique. Le coût pourrait être de l'ordre de 50 000 USD pour la période séparant la CoP17 de la CoP18.

¹ À sa 18^e session, le Comité pour les plantes a maintenu un groupe de travail intersessions sur *Aloe spp.* et *Euphorbia spp.* – inscrites à l'Annexe I – ainsi que sur *Didiereaceae spp.* Les examens requis aux termes des dispositions de la résolution Conf. 14.8 (Rev. CoP16) ont été présentés dans l'annexe 5 du document [PC18 Doc. 16.1.1](#), mais il n'est pas certain qu'il y ait assez d'informations pour que le Comité décide si les critères établis par la résolution Conf. 9.24 (Rev. CoP16) sont ou non remplis. À sa 21^e session, le Comité pour les plantes a reconnu qu'il manque d'informations pour déterminer si les 17 espèces d'*Aloe spp.* inscrites à l'Annexe I; les 17 espèces de *Didiereaceae spp.* inscrites à l'Annexe II et les 10 espèces d'*Euphorbia spp.* inscrites à l'Annexe I sélectionnées pour la période d'examen CoP13-CoP15 sont correctement inscrites aux Annexes. Madagascar a été prié de soumettre une version révisée et mise à jour de l'annexe 5 au document [PC18 Doc. 16.1.1](#) à la 22^e session du Comité pour les plantes, version qui devra inclure des recommandations pour une liste pertinente des espèces avec sa traduction. À la 22^e session du Comité pour les plantes, Madagascar a présenté le document [PC22 Doc. 20.3.1](#). Tout en notant que *Didiereaceae* n'est pas endémique de Madagascar, les orateurs ont soutenu la conclusion de Madagascar, proposant de ne faire aucune modification à l'inscription actuelle de ces espèces. L'examen d'*Aloe helenae* de Madagascar est en cours (voir annexe 1).

Recommandations:

8. Le Comité pour les animaux est invité à :
 - a) commenter les observations du Secrétariat dans le paragraphe 7; et
 - b) prendre note de cette information et décider des nouvelles mesures à prendre en s'appuyant sur les progrès signalés par les Parties concernant les examens en cours.

¹ At PC18, the Committee maintained an intersessional working group on *Aloe* spp. and *Euphorbia* spp. – both listed in Appendix I – and Didiereaceae spp. The reviews required under the provisions of the Resolution Conf. 14.8 (Rev. CoP17) were presented in document [PC18 Doc. 16.1.1, Annex 5](#), but it is not clear if there is enough information for the Committee to decide whether or not the listing criteria established by the Resolution Conf. 9.24 (Rev. CoP16) have been met. The Plants Committee, at its 21st meeting, agreed that there is insufficient information to determine if the 17 species of *Aloe* spp. in Appendix I; 17 species of Didiereaceae spp. in Appendix II and 10 species of *Euphorbia* spp. in Appendix I that were selected for the review period CoP13-CoP15 are appropriately listed in the Appendices. Madagascar was requested to submit a revised and updated version of Annex 5 of document [PC18 Doc. 16.1.1](#) to PC22, which should contain recommendations for the appropriate listing of the species and which should be translated. At PC22, Madagascar introduced document [PC22 Doc. 20.3.1](#). While noting that Didiereaceae was not endemic to Madagascar, speakers supported the conclusion reached by Madagascar, proposing no change to the current listing of these species. The review of *Aloe helenae* from Madagascar is ongoing (see Annex 1).
