VUE D'ENSEMBLE DES ESPÈCES DANS L'EXAMEN PÉRIODIQUE

1. Le présent document a été préparé par le Secrétariat.
2. Dans la résolution Conf. 14.8 (Rev. CoP16), *Examen périodique des espèces inscrites aux Annexes I et II*, la Conférence des Parties décide d'un processus et de lignes directrices selon lesquels le Comité pour les animaux et le Comité pour les plantes entreprennent l'examen périodique des espèces animales et végétales inscrites aux annexes CITES, et dans le paragraphe 6:
 6. *DONNE INSTRUCTION au Secrétariat de tenir un registre des espèces sélectionnées pour un examen périodique, y compris des espèces ayant fait l'objet ou faisant actuellement l'objet d'un examen, dates des documents pertinents du comité, recommandations des examens, et tout rapport et documents liés.*
3. L'annexe 1 contient un registre des espèces végétales sélectionnées pour l'examen entre la 13^e et la 15^e session de la Conférence des Parties (CoP13, Bangkok, 2004 et CoP15, Doha, 2010).
4. Le registre des espèces végétales sélectionnées pour l'examen entre la CoP15 et la 17^e session de la Conférence des Parties CoP17 (CoP17, Johannesburg, 2016) figure en annexe 2.
5. Un résumé de l'ensemble de cas issus des Annexes 1 et 2 (sélectionnées avant la CoP17) encore en cours figure en Annexe 3.
6. Le registre des espèces végétales sélectionnées pour examen entre la CoP17 et la 19^e session de la Conférence des Parties (CoP19, 2022) figure en Annexe 4.
7. Conformément au paragraphe 2 c) de la résolution Conf. 14.8 (Rev. CoP17), le Comité pour les plantes a lancé le dernier examen périodique lors de sa première session après la CoP17, à partir des résultats obtenus selon le paragraphe 2 b) de la résolution [i.e. données sur le commerce et analyse pour la période 2006-2015, préparés à la demande du Secrétariat par le Centre mondial de surveillance de la conservation de la nature du Programme des Nations Unies pour l'environnement (PNUE-WCMC)]. Le Comité a sélectionné une liste de taxons pour examen périodique durant les deux prochaines périodes intersession, soit entre la CoP17 et la 19^e session de la Conférence des Parties en 2022.
8. Lors de sa 23^e session (PC23, Genève, juillet 2017), le Comité pour les plantes a étudié l'information présentée par le document PC23 Doc. 29.2, et sélectionné sept espèces de plantes pour une revue éventuelle selon la résolution Conf. 14.8 (Rev. CoP17). Ces espèces, ainsi que les Annexes auxquelles elles sont inscrites et les États de leur aire de répartition, sont recensés dans le tableau ci-dessous. Les États de l'aire de répartition s'étant déjà proposés pour mener la revue sont en **gras**.

9. Conformément au paragraphe 2 d) de la résolution Conf. 14.8 (Rev. CoP17), le Secrétariat a publié la notification No. 2017/069, le 24 octobre 2017, pour informer toutes les Parties de la liste de taxons proposée pour l'analyse, et pour demander aux États de l'aire de répartition de ces taxons de faire savoir dans les 60 jours (avant le 23 décembre 2017) s'ils sont d'accord pour l'analyse de ces taxons et s'ils accepteraient d'entreprendre ces analyses.
10. Aucune réponse n'a été reçue concernant les espèces végétales sélectionnées pour l'examen. Le Secrétariat espère pouvoir présenter oralement, lors de la présente session, une mise à jour concernant d'autres candidats éventuels pour l'analyse des espèces sélectionnées.
11. Une liste d'abréviations et les codes ISO des pays figurent dans les annexes 5 et 6 respectivement.

Recommandations

12. Le Comité pour les plantes est invité à :
 - a) prendre note du présent document ; et
 - b) s'agissant de l'examen de *Lewisia serrata* soumis par les États-Unis d'Amérique (voir le document PC24 Doc. 25.2.1) et conformément aux dispositions des paragraphes 2 g) et h) de la résolution Conf. 14.8 (Rev. CoP17), décider s'il convient de maintenir le taxon à l'Annexe à laquelle il est actuellement inscrit, de le transférer d'une Annexe à une autre, ou de le supprimer des Annexes ; et dans le cas où l'inscription actuelle serait jugée inappropriée, rédiger un projet de recommandation en se référant aux critères définis dans la résolution Conf. 9.24 (Rev. CoP17), *Critères d'amendement des Annexes I et II*.

¹ At PC18, the Committee maintained an intersessional working group on *Aloe* spp. and *Euphorbia* spp. – both listed in Appendix I – and Didiereaceae spp. The reviews required under the provisions of the Resolution Conf. 14.8 (Rev. CoP17) were presented in document PC18 Doc. 16.1.1, Annex 5, but it is not clear if there is enough information for the Committee to decide whether or not the listing criteria established by the Resolution Conf. 9.24 (Rev. CoP16) have been met. The Plants Committee, at its 21st meeting, agreed that there is insufficient information to determine if the 17 species of *Aloe* spp. in Appendix I; 17 species of Didiereaceae spp. in Appendix II and 10 species of *Euphorbia* spp. in Appendix I that were selected for the review period CoP13-CoP15 are appropriately listed in the Appendices. Madagascar was requested to submit a revised and updated version of Annex 5 of document PC18 Doc. 16.1.1 to PC22, which should contain recommendations for the appropriate listing of the species and which should be translated. At PC22, Madagascar introduced document PC22 Doc. 20.3.1. While noting that Didiereaceae was not endemic to Madagascar, speakers supported the conclusion reached by Madagascar, proposing no change to the current listing of these species. The review of *Aloe helenae* from Madagascar is ongoing (see Annex 1).
