



## NOTIFICATION TO THE PARTIES

**CONCERNING:** 

<u>Invitation to submit information on the implementation of the</u>
Kunming-Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework

- 1. The Secretariat draws the attention of Parties to Notification 2025-099 issued by the Secretariat of the Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD) entitled *Invitation to submit relevant information to support the production of the global report on collective progress in the implementation of the Kunming-Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework*. The Notification is attached for reference.
- 2. The Notification invites relevant organizations, including the secretariats of biodiversity-related conventions and other multilateral environmental agreements (MEAs), to submit information to support the preparation of the global report on collective progress in the implementation of the Kunming-Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework.
- 3. The global report will be considered at the seventeenth meeting of the Conference of the Parties to the Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD COP17; Yerevan, Armenia, October 2026) and will draw upon various sources, including contributions from biodiversity-related conventions such as CITES. The report will include examples of contributions of relevant MEAs towards the implementation of the Framework, in line with their respective mandates [for CITES, see <a href="Decision 17.55">Decision 17.55</a> (Rev. CoP19) on Cooperation with Multilateral Environmental Agreements and other international organizations].
- 4. The contributions of the MEAs to the global report are considered in two ways:
  - a) Through the CBD seventh national reporting Parties are encouraged to engage with their <u>national</u> <u>CBD focal points</u> to support the inclusion of relevant information in the <u>CBD seventh national reports</u>, which will serve as a primary source for the global review.
  - b) Through direct inputs to the CITES Secretariat Parties may also share relevant information with the CITES Secretariat, which plans to collate and analyse data from sources such as CITES implementation reports, the CITES Trade Database, and new listing amendments adopted at CoP20, to contribute to the CBD process.
