CUSTOMS CODE OF THE REPUBLIC OF BELARUS, January 4, 2007 № 204-W

Article 313. The main functions of customs authorities

Таможенные органы выполняют следующие основные функции:

осуществляют таможенное оформление и таможенный контроль, создают условия, способствующие ускорению товарооборота через таможенную границу;

ведут борьбу с контрабандой и иными преступлениями, административными правонарушениями, производство по делам о которых отнесено к компетенции таможенных органов, пресекают незаконный оборот через таможенную границу наркотических средств, оружия, культурных ценностей, радиоактивных веществ, видов животных и растений, находящихся под угрозой исчезновения, их частей и дериватов, объектов интеллектуальной собственности, других товаров, а также оказывают содействие в борьбе с международным терроризмом и пресечении незаконного вмешательства в аэропортах Республики Беларусь в деятельность международной гражданской авиации;

осуществляют в пределах своей компетенции налоговый, валютный, экспортный и иные виды контроля, право на осуществление которых или на участие в осуществлении которых предоставлено таможенным органам в соответствии с законодательством;

ведут таможенную статистику внешней торговли Республики Беларусь и специальную таможенную статистику:

обеспечивают выполнение международных обязательств Республики Беларусь в части, касающейся таможенного дела, осуществляют сотрудничество с таможенными и иными компетентными органами иностранных государств, международными организациями, занимающимися вопросами таможенного дела:

осуществляют информирование и консультирование по вопросам таможенного регулирования и иным вопросам, входящим в компетенцию таможенных органов, обеспечивают в установленном порядке государственные органы, организации и граждан информацией по таможенным вопросам;

осуществляют подготовку, переподготовку и повышение квалификации должностных лиц таможенных органов;

проводят научно-исследовательские работы в области таможенного дела.

Code of the Republic of Belarus "On Administrative Offenses"

Article 15.33. Illegal export from the Republic of Belarus or the import into it of wild animals and wild plants

Незаконные вывоз из Республики Беларусь либо ввоз в нее диких животных, дикорастущих и иных растений, их частей или дериватов, торговля которыми регулируется международными договорами, либо незаконный вывоз из Республики Беларусь диких животных, дикорастущих и иных растений, относящихся к видам, включенным в Красную книгу Республики Беларусь, - влекут наложение штрафа в размере от двадцати до пятидесяти базовых величин, на индивидуального предпринимателя - от двадцати до двухсот базовых величин, а на юридическое липо - до тысячи базовых величин

1. Утвердить прилагаемые:

Положение о порядке и условиях регистрации содержащихся и (или) разведенных в неволе диких животных (включая их потомство, достигшее возраста трех месяпев), относящихся к видам, включенным в Красную книгу Республики Беларусь, либо являющихся образцами СИТЕС;

Правила регулирования распространения и численности диких животных.

- 2. Министерству природных ресурсов и охраны окружающей среды до 24 апреля 2008 г. привести свои нормативные правовые акты в соответствие с настоящим постановлением и принять иные меры по его реализации.
- 3. Настоящее постановление вступает в силу с 24 апреля 2008 г., за исключением пункта 2 и настоящего пункта. вступающих в силу со дня официального опубликования данного постановления.

Regulations on the procedure and conditions contained registration and (or) the captive breeding of wild animals (including their offspring reached the age of three months), belonging to the species listed in Red Book of Belarus, or are examples of CITES

- I. Настоящим Положением определяются порядок и условия регистрации содержащихся и (или) разведенных в неволе диких животных (включая их потомство, достигшее возраста трех месяцев), относящихся к видам, включенным в Красную книгу Республики Беларусь, либо являющихся образнами СИТЕС (далее дикие животные).
- 2. Регистрация диких животных осуществляется Министерством природных ресурсов и охраны окружающей среды (далее Минприроды).
- 3. Для регистрации диких животных владелец диких животных представляет в Минприроды заявление по форме согласно приложению 1.

К заявлению прилагаются:

фотографии подлежащих регистрации диких животных;

- документы, подтверждающие законность владения дикими животными, их частями и (или) дериватами.
- 4. Минприроды в семидневный срок со дня получения заявления рассматривает представленные заявителем документы и принимает решение о регистрации диких животных или об

отказе в регистрации, о чем юридическое и физическое лицо, в том числе индивидуальный предприниматель, письменно уведомляются в пятидневный срок со дня принятия решения.

5. В регистрации диких животных может быть отказано в случае: непредставления документов, указанных в пункте 3 настоящего Положения; представления документов, содержащих недостоверную информацию; несоответствия условий содержания диких животных гребованиям к содержанию диких

животных, установленным Минприроды.

- 6. В случае принятия решения о регистрации диких животных Минприроды в семидневный срок со дня принятия такого решения регистрирует диких животных в журнале учета содержащихся и (или) разведенных в неволе диких животных, относящихся к видам, включенным в Красную книгу Республики Беларусь, либо являющихся образцами СИТЕС по форме согласно приложению 2 и оформляет свидетельство о регистрации содержащихся и (или) разведенных в неволе диких животных, относящихся к видам, включенным в Красную книгу Республики Беларусь, либо являющихся образцами СИТЕС (далее свидетельство о регистрации) по форме согласно приложению 3.
- 7. Бланки свидетельства о регистрации являются бланками строгой отчетности и изготавливаются Минприроды.
- 8. Свидетельство о регистрации подписывается Министром природных ресурсов и охраны окружающей среды или его заместителем и выдается при представлении:

служебного удостоверения - руководителю юридического лица;

свидетельства о государственной регистрации - индивидуальному предпринимателю;

документа, удостоверяющего личность, и доверенности - уполномоченному представителю юридического лица или индивидуального предпринимателя;

документа, удостоверяющего личность, - физическому лицу.

9. Минприроды регистрирует оформленное свидетельство о регистрации в журнале учета свидетельств о регистрации содержащихся и (или) разведенных в неволе диких животных, относящихся к видам, включенным в Красную книгу Республики Беларусь, либо являющихся образцами СИТЕС, по форме согласно приложению 4.
