Annex II

Scientific Authorities

Article 37 of the Law on the protection and management of nature and wild life [153(I)/2003] provide for the establishment of the following four (4) scientific committees:

- (a) <u>Scientific Committee for Aquatic Fauna and Flora species.</u> Members are representatives from the Department of Fisheries and Marine Research (chair), Environment Service and the Department of Veterinary Services.
- (b) <u>Scientific Committee for Terrestrial Flora species.</u> Members are representatives from the Department of Forests (chair), Agricultural Research Institute, Department of Agriculture and the Environment Service.
- (c) <u>Scientific Committee for Avifauna species.</u> Members are representatives from the Game Fund (chair), Department of Forests, Environment Service and the Department of Veterinary Services.
- (d) <u>Scientific Committee for Terrestrial Fauna species</u>. Members are representatives from the Environment Service (chair), Department of Forests, Department of Veterinary Services and Game Fund.

All members are permanently employed public servants.
